Physicians have about 23 months left to prepare for the implementation of *ICD-10*. This totally new diagnosis coding system will require physicians to be more specific with their diagnosis coding. Not only do the coders need to understand how to use the new code set, the vast majority of physicians need to make major changes in how they currently document patients' diagnoses.

To help members begin preparations for this transition, Newby Consulting, Inc. (NCI) has engaged the services of ICDExpert. This company has invested significant resources into their train-the-trainer program and has an American Health Information Management Association (AHIMA) certified trainer, Pat Schmitter, to assist members in identifying how the change from *ICD-9* to *ICD-10* will affect their claims on October 1, 2013.
